Summer Employment Opportunities

(All staff must be at least 18 years old, unless otherwise specified.)

Adventure Program Coordinator

Responsible for safety standards at any “Adventure Program”, including (but not limited to): climbing tower, high ropes, low ropes, slacklining, etc. Supervises and assists staff running the activities.

Arts & Crafts Coordinator



Responsible for leadership of the arts and crafts program. This includes planning activities, ordering supplies and providing an inventory of materials at the end of the season.

Chapel Coordinator

Responsible for many aspects of the spiritual life at Crescent Lake, from leading Chapel times for younger campers to assisting counselors with in-cabin devotions. Musical ability is desired.

Day Camp Counselors (Age 16+)

Day Camp Counselors work with our Day Camp programs to provide age-appropriate activities that help campers build self-esteem and develop a relationship with God.

Lead Counselor

The Lead Counselor reports directly to the Camp Director to ensure quality programs and service to our campers and provide leadership to the Staff.

Lifeguard (Age 16+)

Lifeguards will assist the Waterfront Director in coordinating all aquatic activities, including boating, swimming, etc. Requires current Red Cross Lifeguard certifications.

Missions Trip / Wilderness Trip Leaders

Trip Leaders are expected to be role models and relationship builders for the Wilderness Trip programs. Primarily responsible for the health and safety of program participants off-site. Advanced certifications preferred (i.e. WFR, WEMT, etc.). Ordination or strong Christian leadership experience required.

Nature Program Coordinator

The Nature Program Coordinator will work with the Northern Lakes Impact Center to create outdoor, educational opportunities for campers.

Target-Sport Program Coordinator

Responsible for all target sports, including archery, paintball, primitive hunting and riflery. Will require cleaning and repair of the different tools that are used. Previous experience a plus.

Resident Camp Counselors

Counselors are expected to be role models and relationship builders for the resident camp programs. Also responsible for: leading devotions, building camper self-esteem and helping them to develop a relationship with God.

Waterfront Director

In charge of all waterfront activities including boating and swimming lessons. Requires current Red Cross, WSI and Lifeguard certifications or current Lifeguard with Head Lifeguard and Waterfront certifications.

Waterskiing Assistant

Works with our Waterskiing Ministry team to assist in teaching, driving and program safety. Wisconsin boating certification and Red Cross Lifeguard is required! (Will serve as a Counselor in non-program times.)

Fall / Winter / Spring Opportunities

(All staff must be at least 18 years old.)

Lead Instructor

Responsible for the day-to-day operations during the Outdoor Education program. The Lead Instructor reports directly to the Camp Director to ensure quality programs and service to our campers and provide leadership to the Staff.

Outdoor Education Instructor

Responsible for leading an assigned group of students from local schools through various activities, including: teaching environmental science and historical reenactments, organizing games, singing and other campfire activities.

Teambuilding Facilitator

Responsible for leading our Teambuilding and Challenge Course activities, which includes: Climbing Tower, High Ropes Course, High Teams Course, Initiatives, Low Ropes Courses, Wilderness Trips and much more. This position is part-time, on-call to fit your schedule.
