Dear Group Leaders,

Thank you so much for your interest and continued support of Crescent Lake Bible Camp. After reviewing the best practices recommended by the CDC, American Camping Association, the State of Wisconsin, and the local Health Department, we are excited to be available to host your group this summer.

We are working diligently to make sure that Crescent Lake Bible Camp remains a safe place for our campers and staff through this summer of COVID-19. We will continue to monitor the local health department's regulations as well as guidance from the CDC to ensure that we are doing all that we can to help your group members stay healthy.

We are hopeful that the following information will be helpful to you as you consider your participation in Summer 2020:

1. Health Screening

Upon arrival, we will ask you to confirm that no one in your group has (or has had) a fever in the last 72-hours. We will also ask a few questions meant to determine clear risk factors as recommended by the CDC. Mainly, we will ask if anyone in your group:

1. Has traveled from an area with a current widespread COVID-19,
2. Traveled outside of the country or been in close contact with someone who has traveled out of the country, or
3. If anyone in your group has been in close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last two weeks.

To help stop the spread of the coronavirus, we do ask that you voluntarily stay home if you experience a fever within three days prior to arriving at CLBC or answer yes to any of the questions listed above within 14 days of arriving at CLBC.

Guests who have had COVID-19 symptoms must be fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever reducing medications, have improvement in respiratory symptoms, and had at least 7 days since the symptoms first appeared.

2. Continuous Health Monitoring

If a group member is displaying or complaining of any symptoms recognized by the CDC as related to the coronavirus (fever, dry cough, shortness of breath), they will be isolated and asked to visit the local Emergency Room. If the COVID-19 test comes back positive or the ER visit is refused, the camper will be asked to leave CLBC for the safety of the other campers. **Please be sure to read the COVID-19 Policy so that you know how we will handle exposure to confirmed cases as well as the return of staff who have recovered from COVID-19.**

3. Social Distancing / Small Group Sizes

You may notice some differences in our schedule / facility use as we work to accommodate the requirements of our governing bodies. We will keep you posted to the changes so that you know what to expect when you arrive.

4. Cleaning and Disinfecting

As we continue to work through the county-directed phases to reopen businesses and other areas, **I want to assure you that we will continue handling the cleaning and disinfecting of camp in accordance with local and national guidelines.** For example, dishes run through hot water, detergents, and sanitizers as required by the Health Department. We also use detergent and sanitizers on our tables and other hard surfaces. Our bathrooms, game rooms, and other high-traffic areas are already wiped down daily with cleaners, sanitizers, and soapy water. We will continue to do this with our program areas as well as give special attention to other high-touch areas (door handles, railings, light switches, etc.) to help your group members stay healthy while at camp. Again, most of this is already our routine and meets the CDC recommendations for facilities like ours.

It is always our goal to provide an amazing experience for your group. Please be patient with us as the Check-In might take a bit longer but, in the long run, we feel that this process is best for your campers, other families, and our staff.
